Organising your hospital appointment



We will write to you to tell you when to come for your appointment.



If you have a problem with the date or time of your appointment please call the number on the letter. We can arrange a new time for you.



If you do not come for your appointment without letting us know, you may have to go back to your GP before we can see you.



Before you come to the hospital



Before you come to the hospital please read your appointment letter carefully.

It will tell you if you need to do anything before your appointment. If you need help to do this please ask your family or friend for help.



Your letter will tell you where you need to go.



Please call the hospital on 01793 604020 before you come to hospital if you need help or support during your visit.



Getting to the hospital



You may like to ask a friend or family member to come with you. You should allow two hours for your appointment.



There are several sign posted public parking areas. You will need to pay to park your car.



There are also disabled parking spaces. Disabled parking is free.



Buses 16, 12 and 70a go from Swindon bus station to the hospital. Please call Thamesdown Buses on 01793 428428 for details of other buses to the hospital.



Your outpatient appointment



There are two entrances to the hospital. Your letter will tell you which one to use.



When you get to the outpatient department tell the receptionist at the desk you have arrived.

The receptionist will check your details and ask you to sit in the waiting area.



Sometimes you may have to wait to be seen.





When it is time for you to see the doctor you will be called by a nurse or your doctor into a clinic room.

The doctor will ask you questions. You may be asked to remove some of your clothes to be examined.

Please ask if you are not sure about anything.



After your appointment you may be asked to visit other departments for some tests such as blood tests or an x-ray.

The nurse will explain and direct you to where you need to go.

	You may also want to think about what it is you want to tell the doctor about how you are feeling. You can write this down here so you don't forget.






Bring your appointment letter with you to your appointment.
